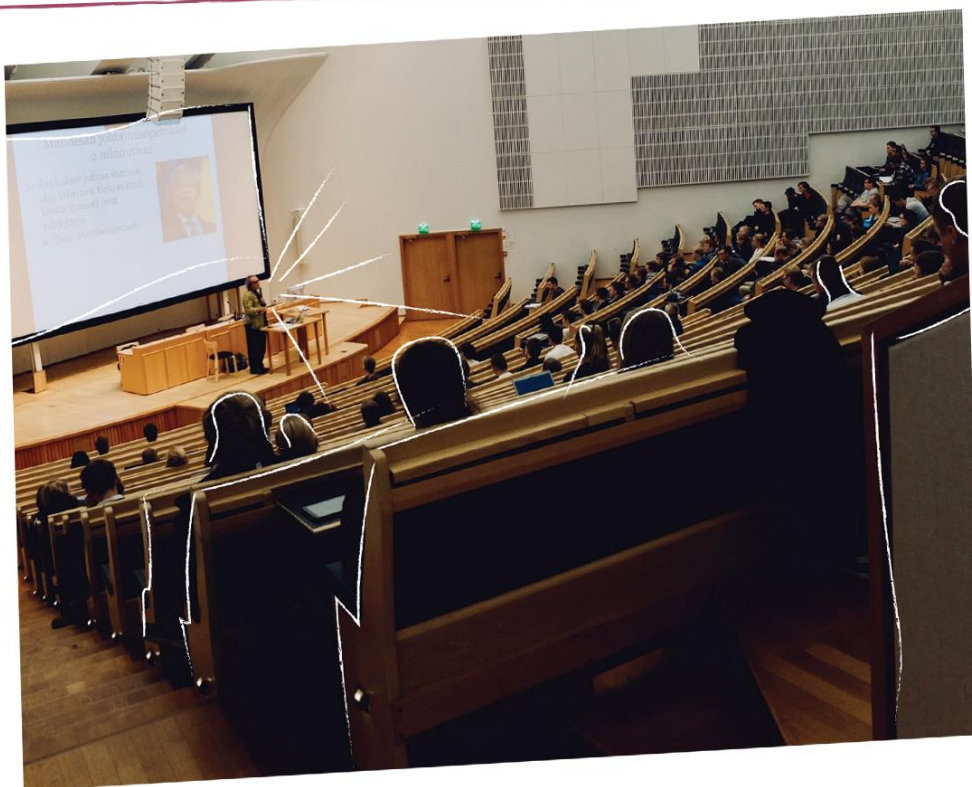

ELECTED ROLES

Class representatives: The Student Union runs elections each year to facilitate students voting for representatives in their year group on their programme. The role of this person includes representing the interests of the year group on the programme at Faculty or Programme committees. They also meet with the Year Head of the programme to discuss suggestions, comments or issues that might be raised by students with their class representative.

The Class representative often also communicates with the year group through online messaging apps or email about events, issues or opportunities that are relevant to the students on the programme. The role of class representative can be an interesting one as it gives you an insight into the running of the programme, an opportunity to show leadership and a chance to learn about the work of the Student Union and to get involved with the activities across the university.
